

## **Brixhibition Lego Challenge 2018**

## School Information and Conditions of entry for individual Students

The Tasmanian Brick Enthusiasts Inc. invites all Primary Schools and Primary School Children in the Launceston and Northern Tasmania area to compete in a Lego Competition running in the first term of 2018.

(for schools with less than 12 student participating, we recommend entering as a team)

## For schools with more than 12 participating students there are 3x age groups (with a least 4 students per age group)

- Prep Grade 2 winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- Grade 3 4 winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)
- Grade 5 6 winner to receive a winner's medallion (Age Group or Age Group & Overall Winner)



Your school then must pick 1 overall winner from the age group winners, to represent your school at Brixhibition.

The overall winner will receive 1x "Age Group & Overall" winners' medallion

The overall winner will also win 1x free pass to Village cinemas, 1x free pass to Beaconsfield Heritage

Museum, 1x free pass to Paringa Archery and a free pass to Brixhibition.

Each Primary School can determine their own Lego challenge winner with the following rules and conditions.
