

Tips on how to write a book review

If you are not sure how to write a review, these ideas may help get you started.

- Choose a book, it does not have to be your favourite book.
- Read the book, just before you write your review.
- Then answer the questions.
 - **The name of the book I read is...**
Copy the title of the book from the cover. Check that you have every word.
 - **It was written by...**
Copy the name of the author from the cover. Check the spelling. If there is an illustrator, you can add "and illustrated by" then write the name.
 - **This book is...**
Choose words that match the book. If there isn't a word that matches, you can choose "Other".
 - **In my words, this book is about...**
Tell us something about them, and what they do in the story.
 - **I give this book a rating of...**
Choose a rating between one sad face and five happy faces.
 - **My book review is for...**
You can choose a team if you would like.
- Read your review out loud, does it make sense?
- Fix any mistakes and make changes if you need to.
